Psalm 139 is a beautiful expression of God's heart and his promises towards us. It tells how he knew us before we were born; how he sees us and everything that goes on with us. It tells us that no matter where we go—even if it's dark and deep—still, God knows where we are and he loves us. David (the writer of this Psalm), upon seeing and pondering how deep God's love is for him, ends this Psalm with a prayer, "Search me, O God, see if there is anything wicked in me." (See 139:23-24)

We didn't have space to include the entire Psalm here, but if you have a Bible (or know someone who does), try to find Psalm 139, and read the whole thing.
